PUBLIC OUTREACH & EDUCATION - PETA conducts educational campaigns and publishes materials that are distributed to students, teachers, the general public, and supporters. These efforts include materials made available through our programs for younger children, high school and college students, and educators, as well as publications including factsheets, booklets, fliers, posters, and publication of PETA's magazines, Grrr! and Animal Times. Programs involved renowned celebrities, extensive media attention, interactive Web site features resulting in skyrocketing traffic, and Public Service Announcements typically placed for free in high-exposure outlets.

RESEARCH, INVESTIGATIONS & RESCUE - PETA receives complaints of cruelty to animals, rescues and obtains care for abused, neglected and at-risk animals, investigates cruelty cases, gathers evidence of law violations, and takes action to ensure enforcement of laws and regulations that could protect the animals concerned. We publicized the results of our investigation into AgriProcessors, the world's largest glatt kosher slaughterhouse, where federal laws were ignored and workers mutilated fully conscious animals and electrically shocked their faces, and a Tyson slaughterhouse in Heflin, AL, where workers routinely ripped the heads off chickens, scalded them to death, and mutilated them. We worked with many prosecutors to make sure that animal abusers, including those who tortured family dogs and cats, were held responsible for their actions. Our wildlife department helped resolve conflicts with beavers using non-lethal methods at nine locations in southeastern Virginia. We introduced shareholder resolutions at the annual meetings of 20 major pharmaceutical and chemical companies asking them to replace five common animal poisoning tests with currently available non-animal methods. We also funded a highly successful spay/neuter program which made surgeries available at little or no cost to disadvantaged animal guardians, preventing thousands of unwanted litters and providing relief to overburdened, government run animal control offices and local shelters.

INTERNATIONAL GRASSROOTS CAMPAIGNS - PETA organizes campaigns to inform the public how animals are abused in, among other places, the meat, clothing, testing, and entertainment industries. In Fiscal Year 2005, PETA persuaded retailers Suzy Shier, Forever 21, H & M, and Wet Seal to stop carrying fur items, saving animals from cruel deaths such as anal electrocution and live skinning; convinced Mercedes-Benz to offer non-leather interiors in its cars; caused PETCO to end its selling of large birds, who typically suffer from inadequate space and socializing when in captivity; helped save ducks from immeasurable suffering by participating in the successful campaign to ban foie gras in California; promoted cruelty-free diets through our "Sexiest Vegetarian Alive" contests, garnering international media attention; and raised awareness about

Note 1 Fixed assets are recorded at their cost and are depreciated using the straight line method, half year convention over their useful lives. Furniture, Fixture, Equipment and Vehicles are estimated to have useful lives ranging from 3 to 10 years. Buildings and improvements have useful lives ranging from 5 to 50 years. Improvements are amortized over the lesser of the remaining life of the lease or the estimated useful life of the improvements. Expenditures for major repairs are capitalized while minor costs or items with a useful life of less than a year are expensed when incurred. Upon retirement or diposal of assets, the cost and accumulated depreciation and amortization are eliminated from the accounts and the resulting gain or loss is included in the Statement of Activities.
